The **Reference & Government Information Department** of Meyer Library presents a Readers' Advisory Program and Display featuring the Missouri State University Libraries' collections that chronicle the fascinating history of *The British Monarchy*. The royals were a powerful and complex group. They lived lives of privilege, dictated and guided by ceremony and duty. They were loved and hated, honored and adored, ridiculed and persecuted. They have been a dichotomous mix of leaders great and strong, weak and petty, inspired and inept, faulted and fated. They have been portrayed in books, theatre, song, and film, including the recent (2006), *The Queen*, starring Best Actress Oscar winner, Helen Mirren.
