In conjunction with The History Channel's commemoration of the 60th anniversary of the death of Franklin Delano Roosevelt, "**FDR: A Presidency Revealed**," the Reference Department of Meyer Library presents a Readers' Advisory Program & Display with pictures and library resources remembering FDR and his presidency. Admired by Winston Churchill who regarded his life as "one of the commanding events in human history" and Bill Clinton who referred to him as "Captain Courageous," FDR led America out of the depression and into a war that galvanized the world. He is remembered for his "New Deal" plan to restore America coming out of the Great Depression, clearing the way for peace, including the establishment of the United Nations. We invite readers to the *New Books Area of Meyer Library* to explore and remember the Presidency of FDR.
