An educated citizen is a well read citizen engaged not only in community action but also in thoughtful intellectual study in order to know how to act and help solve issues facing the community. Without liberally educated and well read citizens, democracy cannot sustain itself.

**Coordinating with SMSU's Public Affairs Week (PAW) celebration**, September 23-28, 2003 and the University mission to develop educated persons to help them become responsible citizens, the **Reference Department of Meyer Library** kicks off its Fall 2003 Readers' Advisory Program & Displays with **Public Affairs: Citizenship, Community, Democracy**. The display features a small sample of SMSU Libraries' excellent collections and resources relating to the concepts of citizenship, community, and democracy, and to local, national and global issues in public affairs including education, health, economic development, creative arts, and science and the environment.

In conjunction with its public affairs initiatives, SMSU has had a number of distinguished speakers who have come to campus to address citizenship and other public affairs issues, including Nobel Prize winners, **F.W. de Klerk** and **Elie Wiesel**, former U.S. **Senator Bill Bradley**, American sociologist and educator **Robert Bellah**, educator, **Neil Postman**, 1997 Inaugural Poet **Miller Williams**, and senior editor of *The Wall Street Journal* **Joseph N. Boyce**.

Included in the display collections are selected books and articles by and about some of these speakers, as well as original documents chronicling the beginning of SMSU's statewide mission in public affairs (1995), recognition of SMSU before the U.S. House of Representatives (1997), and the establishment of the Missouri Campus Compact, "a coalition of college and university presidents committed to helping students develop the values and skills of citizenship." (From the "Resolution to Charter Missouri Campus Compact" December 7, 2000).
