The **Reference & Government Information Department** of Meyer Library presents a Readers' Advisory Program and Display, ***With Malice Toward None: Abraham Lincoln ★ 200 Years 1809-2009***, celebrating the 200th anniversary of Lincoln's birth and featuring recommended reading from the Library's rich collections relating to Abraham Lincoln's life and legacy.

In 1963, an essay commemorating Lincoln's Gettysburg address was published in *Time* magazine entitled, "Fanfare for the Common Man," which opened with these words,

"He [Lincoln] is the greatest, the classic, the archetypical individual in the American imagination...because [he] embodied a notable American type: the common man who is uncommon."
